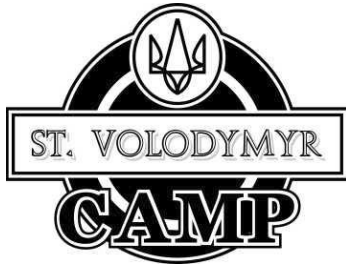


CONTRACT OFFICE SERVICES – EXECUTIVE SECRETARY/EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The Freedom of the Creator

Holy Scripture begins the account of the creation of the world with these words: "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth" Gn 1:1. God was, is, and remains always "in the beginning" of everything created, and all that comes forth in time. The evangelist John writes about God as the beginning of everything: "I am the Alpha and the Omega, says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty" Rev 1:8. Saint Irenaeus of Lyons writes that all things came forth from the hands of God, by the Word and the Holy Spirit.

God is the Creator. This means that God not only created the world, but he is always present in his creation, and that he is always creating. Hence, creation is a sign and expression of God's creative love. Though human beings, creation is called to respond to love with love, and to long for God as God longs for them: "God desires that he might be desired and he loves that he might be loved".
