Did you know?

As the Book of Genesis tell us, God created the human being out of the “dust of the earth” – matter breathing into us the “breath of life,” by virtue of which the human being becomes a “living being” 2:7. Holy Scripture portrays the Creator with the image of a potter, who moulds humankind according to his Image from the clay. This Image Gn 1:27 is the incarnate Son of God: “He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation” Col 1:15. Humankind is created in the image of the Son:

Now God... modelled [the human being] after his own Son; for by the hands of the Father, that is, by the Son and the Holy Spirit, the whole human being, and not [merely] a part of it, was made in the likeness of God. ...for the perfect human being consists in the commingling and the union of the soul receiving the Spirit of the Father, and the admixture of that fleshly nature that was moulded after the image of God
