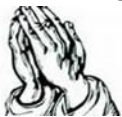

## **Did you know...? Humankind - in the Image and Likeness of God**

The Book of Genesis reveals a profound bond between humankind and God: “Let us make humankind in our image, according to our likeness” 1:26. As affirmed by the Holy Fathers, humankind in its essence is the image of the Prototype - the inexpressible, unknowable and immortal God. Humankind has the capacity of intellect and free will and the interior power of self-determination. Thus, the Holy Fathers affirm that the image of God in humankind is the ground of our being, existence, and personal self-determination.

### **Comment:**

The image and likeness of God in the human being indicate that God reflected himself in the human being. The image of God - is a power by which God makes people rulers over the visible world. God entrusted people power, similar as God himself is the Lord over all. Likeness of God - is a performing of good deeds. Just as God does good deeds so he has put into the human nature to do good deeds as an inseparable component of the human nature. God is the source of good, who creates only good, and everything which he creates he does it very well. So, this feature of doing good deeds he endowed human beings in order that human being reflected his Creator who does only good. After the fall into sin human beings lost the image of God. Because of the presence of sin human beings became the slave instead to being ruler. At that moment the human being becomes the image of the evil instead of being the image of the goodness, and becomes a slave of sin instead of being ruler over all.
