## **Did you know...?**

### The Church is Holy

In Holy Scripture, the Lord God refers to himself as the Holy one: “For I am God and no mortal, the Holy One in your midst” (Hos 11:9). This God calls humankind to become like him in holiness: “For I am the Lord your God; sanctify yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy” (Lev 11:44). God’s holiness for the Church.

### Comment:

By these words, the Lord does not mean impeccability and infallibility of each of us. He knows that it is impossible for man to be impeccable and infallible, because there is no man who would not sin. Instead, the Lord speaks of holiness, that is, that we always remember God’s presence and purposefulness toward God. The Church is God’s institution and we are it. The Lord calls for us to do everything we can to be his children and to act according to the teachings of our Father. Although the Church consists of us, sinners, the Church is called holy because she is sanctified by the Holy Sacraments. Therefore, impeccability and infallibility belong only to God, who sanctifies the Church by his blood, which we partake of in the Holy Communion. So, our task is to connect with God as close as possible and implement to the maximum his words in our lives.
