Just a reminder that annual family memberships are \$400.00 and single memberships are \$200.00.

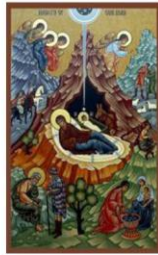


Notice from your Chancery Office Office Maintenance & Christmas Closure
