**The parish is missing the old hall tables and chairs from the shed. If anyone knows where they are, we would appreciate their return.**

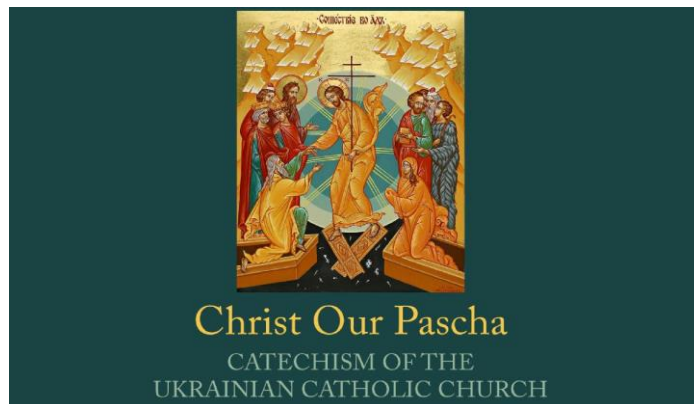
**Notice from your Chancery Office: Office Maintenance & Christmas Closure**
