1. **Transition in Life**-On January 21st (starting around 1:00pm), Brenda Pasloski will come to present the Transition in Life three hour session, which will provide information and support to those that are thinking about making life changes or need to make changes. If you are interested, please let Deacon Harrold know that you are attending. Here is a brief description as submitted by the presenter: As we age, there are many dynamics of our life that can gradually or suddenly change. The presentation looks at how we age – physically, socially, cognitively, psychologically, spiritually. Often people are not prepared for sudden change and do not know what resources are available to them. The presentation is not only for those that are retired and looking at making changes, but their families, or supports systems, that often are the ones that are responsible for planning and carrying out that plan. We will discuss role changes, caregiver stress, depression and loneliness, and grief. To alleviate stress and anxiety, being as independent and healthy as can be, this presentation will look at will provide information regarding resources in the community. This may be housing, home care, private care, long term care, transportation, Lifeline, and other resources that may be available. In planning ahead, discussed will be power of attorneys, wills, advanced directives, guardianship, and funerals. The end result of the Life Transitions Program is so people can move along a continuum of life with the least amount of stress and confusion, allowing for their time and energy to be used focusing on their spirituality, reflection, on their family or caregivers, and on prayer.
