Hey Saskatchewan Youth in Grades 7-12!

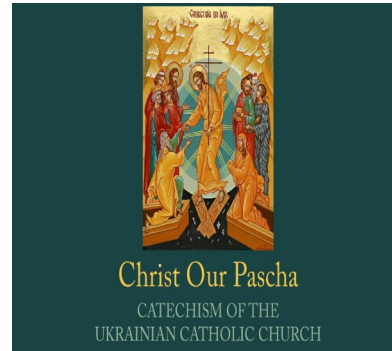
