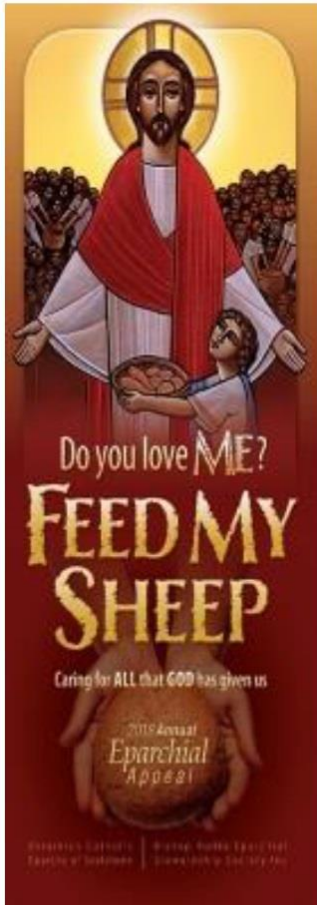
EPARCHIAL EVENTS (Information about all the following events is on the Eparchial web site)
