UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC EPARCHY OF SASKATOON LAY FORMATION PROGRAM

BEING TRANSFORMED INTO THE IMAGE OF GOD

This program would be offered in Prince Albert if there are enough people interested. The program would be held from 8:30am-4:00pm on one Saturday a month for 10 months (excluding the months of July and August). (The exact time and start dates are to be determined.) The cost for the entire course would be approximately \$80.00 (program costs are still to be finalized).

The content of the lay formation program is planned so as to provide a progressive development through five basic stages of Christian conversion: scripture, spirituality, Liturgy, theology and ministry.

Each month, time is set aside for spiritual formation, prayer and reflection, liturgical preparation, and development of a life-giving spiritual experience.

The program is designed to help candidates:

- Understand the richness of our Eastern Church by studying our Liturgy, Theology, Spirituality and Traditions.
- Grow in personal and liturgical prayer through active participation in various Eastern liturgical services as well as a personal prayer program.
- Deepen their baptismal commitment and to realize that their lives as baptized Christians are essentially ministerial.
- Grow in the areas of community building, ecumenism, and outreach to the unchurched alienated, and disadvantaged.
