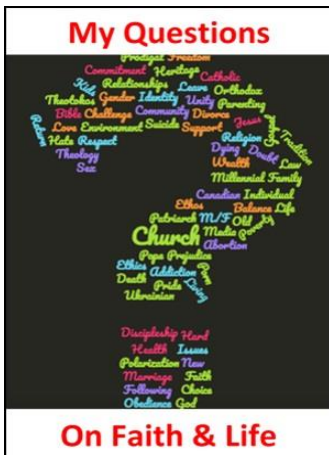

Join the "Call for Conscience": We, Catholics, Christians and all people of good will are asking the Saskatchewan legislature to create and support a bill which would deal with conscience rights for doctors, nurses and healthcare professionals who cannot participate in euthanasia/assisted suicide in good conscience. One way to show your support for this campaign is to go to the Call for Conscience website at www.CanadiansforConscience.ca/saskatchewan to learn more, join the "Call for Conscience" and write directly to your Health Ministers asking them to support legislative protection for Saskatchewan healthcare professionals. You may also join us after the Divine Liturgies on the weekend of February 24th to sign letters to our Health Ministers. **These letters are included in your bulletin** ready for your Name, Signature, address and email address on February 24th. It is hoped that the Campaign will not only raise awareness of the need for this legislation but generate over 14,000 letters to be presented at the Legislature, to make our views known in support of Conscience Protection laws in our Province.
