

**Mission Days 2019 -The Vibrant Parish "A Place to Encounter the Living Christ"**

**From Ascension to Pentecost. This spiritual exercise is valuable when it is prayed as a community, a family or an individual. Consider investing the minutes required to pray together with Ukrainian Catholics from around the world. This is available in both Ukrainian and English. May God reward you abundantly with His gift of the Holy Spirit. ~ Just me, Fr Ivan Nahachewsky ~ Prayers are listed below.**

**Day 1 Prayer:** When You had fulfilled Your plan for us and united things on earth with those in heaven, You ascended in glory, O Christ our God, in no way distant, but remaining inseparable, You cried to those who love You: I am with You and there is none against you.

**Day 2 Prayer:** Come, O faithful, let us climb the Mount of Olives with the apostles, let us lift our minds and hearts on high. Let us behold the Lord as He is taken up. Let us cry out with joy and thanksgiving. Glory to Your ascension, O most merciful One.

**Day 3 Prayer:** Lord, I am here. Lord, I am Yours! (Let us repeat this prayer throughout the day.)

**Day 4 Prayer:** Remember, O Lord, those who have brought these gifts, and those for whom, through whom, and on behalf of whom they have been brought. Remember, O Lord, those who bear fruit and do good work in Your holy churches, and who remember the poor. Reward them with Your riches and heavenly gifts of grace; for earthly things grant them heavenly ones; for temporal ones, eternal, for corruptible, incorruptible.

**Day 5 Prayer:** May our mouths be filled with Your praise, O Lord, that we may sing of Your glory. For You made us worthy to partake of Your holy divine, immortal and life-giving Mysteries. Preserve us in Your holiness that we may meditate all the day upon Your justice. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

**Day 6 Prayer:** In the morning, we were filled with Your mercy, and we rejoiced and were glad in all our days. Let us be glad in return for the days when You humbled us, the years when we saw evils. Look upon Your servants and upon Your work and guide their children. May the radiance of the Lord our God be upon us and direct the work of our hands for us; direct the work of our hands.

**Day 7 Prayer:** Remember, O Lord, the people here present and those who are absent for just causes and have mercy on them and on us according to the multitude of Your mercy. Fill their storehouses with every good thing; preserve their marriages in peace and concord; nourish the infants, guide the young, strengthen the aged; comfort the fainthearted; gather the scattered; bring back the wayward, and join them to Your holy, catholic and apostolic Church.

**Day 8 Prayer:** For You, Lord, are the help of the helpless, the hope of those without hope, the Savior of the storm-tossed, the haven of those at sea, the physician of the sick. Be all things to all people, O You Who know each one and their request, each household and its needs. Deliver, O Lord, this city (this village, this monastery), and every city, town and village, from famine, plague, earthquake, flood fire, sword, foreign invasion and civil war.

**Day 9 Prayer:** The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

**Day 10 Prayer:** Blessed are You, O Christ our God who revealed the fishermen as most wise by sending them the Holy Spirit; through them You caught the entire world. Loving Master, glory to You.


