2020 Sobor

In preparation for the VII session of the Patriarchal Sobor that is to take place on August 25-29, 2020 in Lviv, Ukraine, the Eparchy of Saskatoon will hold a Sobor on April 4, 2020 in Saskatoon. The main topics of discussion at this Sobor will be:

- Immigration/Migration
- Settlement
- Unity of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church

Other topics for discussion can be:

- Discuss and reflect on our Eparchy's strengths and weaknesses.
- Opportunities and challenges facing our Saskatoon Eparchy in the areas of immigration, migration, settlements, and unity of our parishes and Eparchy.
- What are the pastoral needs of our faithful today?
- What are effective ways to reach out to our faithful?
- How can we reach out and reconnect with the people who have left our parish communities?
- What is the evangelization and mission spirit in our parish communities?

Clergy, religious, parish council presidents, pastoral council members and Eparchial office and ministries staff can add more topics if they wish. The resolutions from our Sobor will be forwarded to the organizing committee of the VII Patriarchal Sobor in Ukraine. It is obligatory for all clergy to attend this Sobor and we also ask that each parish/pastoral district send at least 2 other representatives to this Sobor. It is suggested that the Eparchial Pastoral Council members initiate a discussion within their districts/parishes and bring a summary of the discussion to the Sobor. If you wish to attend the Sobor or have opinions to share please contact Father Basil.
