If any services are needed, please call the rectory at 306-763-3645, and your call will be forwarded to a parish cell phone and Dcn Harrold will help organize.

If you or a family member are admitted to the hospital, your/their patient file **will not** include a spiritual contact person. If you or your loved one would like to have spiritual services that only a priest can provide, such as hearing confession, anointing or blessing of the sick, last rites, baptism, staff at the hospital that are caring for you or your loved one will contact someone for you at your request. The same applies if you have a loved one in a care home. The nurse on duty has a list of clergy members to call.
