### Welcome Back

Father Basil and the Parish Council would like to welcome back our parishioners after the last few months of closure due to the COVID19 pandemic. As of June 22, churches have been allowed to re-open with a 30% capacity limit. .

1. For the next few Sundays, please call Barb Kuschak at 795-2527 to register to attend each Sunday service.
2. Please know that we continue to be given dispensation from attending physical services. Please stay home if you are symptomatic, feeling unwell, or are medically vulnerable.
3. Liturgies will continue to be livestreamed for those unable to attend services.
4. Please use the sanitizer station at the back of the church before entering.
5. All books have been removed from the pews. Please take both a liturgy and tropar book home with you and bring them to each service you attend.

6. The collection basket will be at the back of the church when you enter.
  7. Communion will not be given in church during the service but you may call Father Basil to make an appointment to receive it if you wish.
  8. There will be no schedule of readers, ushers, and office duty people as we don't know who will be at church each week. Please consider volunteering if you are attending services.
  9. Bulletins will be provided after liturgy.
  10. We must use separate doors for entering and exiting the church. The main front doors will be used for entering the church and the two side doors will be used to exit the church.
  11. In order to comply with physical distancing guidelines, pews that are not to be used will be blocked off. Please ensure that you sit only in the designated pews. Please do not remove the tape from the pews.
- We are all wading through uncharted waters as we return to our worship services. If we all do our part, we can return to some sort of normalcy over the coming weeks. Thank you for your patience and cooperation. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact any of your Parish Council members.
