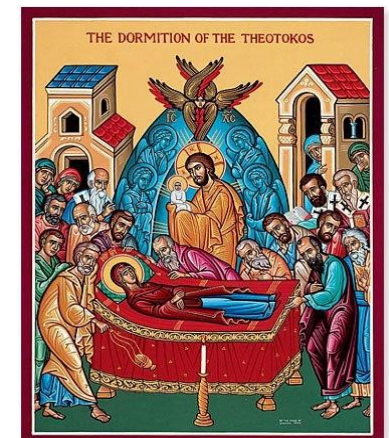

### Special Propers for Saturday, August 15, 2020

**Tropar Festive, tone 1:** O Mother of God, in giving birth you still preserved virginity\*, and in your falling asleep you did not forsake the world.\* You are the Mother of Life and have been transferred to life,\* and through your prayers have delivered our souls from death.

**Sunday Tropar, tone 2:** When You went down to death, O Life Immortal,\* You struck Hades dead with the blazing light of your divinity.\* When you raised the dead from the nether world,\* all the powers of heaven cried out:\* "O Giver of life, Christ our God, glory be to You!"

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and ever. Amen!

**Sunday, Kondak, tone 2:** You rose from the tomb, O almighty Saviour;\* and Hades, seeing this wonder, was stricken with fear; and the dead arose.\* Creation saw and rejoices with You, and Adam exults.\* And the world, my Saviour, sings Your praises forever.

**Kondak, tone 2:** The grave and death did not detain the Mother of God.\* She prays perpetually and is our unfailing hope of intercession;\* for He who dwelt in the womb of the ever-Virgin,\* transferred to life the Mother of Life.

**Prokimen, tone 2:** The Lord is my strength and my song of praise, and He has become my salvation.

**Verse:** The Lord has indeed chastised me, but He has not delivered me to death.

**Prokimen, tone 3:** My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Saviour.

**Alleluia Verses:** The Lord will hear you in the day of tribulation; the name of the God of Jacob will shield you.

Lord, grant victory to the king, and hear us in the day that we shall call upon You.

Hear, O daughter, and see, and incline your ear.
