CONFESSION: If anyone wishes to avail themselves of the sacrament of confession/reconciliation, come to the front of the iconostas before liturgy from **9:30 to 9:50**. When Father is ready, you can come to the sacristy (Father's side, on the left hand side), and stand in the doorway but do not enter the sacristy. (This seems to be the most workable way, for now and allows for safe distancing).
