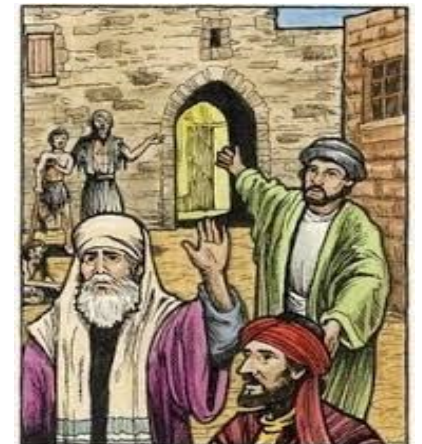

1. Please call Barb Kuschak at 795-2527 to register to attend each Sunday. Should the need arise to contact people, an accurate attendance list is essential.
2. Dispensation is still given from attending physical services. Please stay home if you are symptomatic, feeling unwell, or are medically vulnerable.
3. Liturgies continue to be livestreamed for those unable to attend services.
4. Please use the sanitizer station at the back of the church before entering.
5. The collection basket is at the back. Please leave your envelope on your way into church.
6. Please ensure you sit only in the designated pews. Do not remove the tape. It makes it much easier for the volunteers to clean the pews after church if they only have to do the designated spots.
7. Communion is completely voluntary. It will be given at the end of every liturgy. Everyone receives a separate spoon.
8. Bulletins will be handed out after church.
9. Use the designated doors for entering and exiting the church.
10. Be sure not to leave any books or papers in the pews when you leave the church.

Dear Excellency,

As you unfortunately know, COVID-19 continues. I pray that you are safe and healthy. Our home missions are struggling, but I don't need to tell you that. I am concerned about the people in our missions, but also worried about our donors, as some have succumbed to the virus. The Lord bless them and let their good deeds go before them that they may see His face.

Fundraising for our missions is harder because of lockdowns and restrictions on gatherings for places of worship. We depend on Diocesan/Eparchial collections and my preaching in parishes and conventions, which isn't happening.

May I make a simple request? Only if it's possible, could you increase your donation by \$5 or \$10? My thinking is that our emergency needs must still be covered. If you can help, our bishops would appreciate it. But only if you can for these are hard times.
