There are also many church services available on line through live streaming, by going to the Eparchial website.

Reminder: When you attend Divine Liturgy, either on Sunday or Thursday, it is very important that you register that you have been in attendance. This is vital for contact tracing in the event of an outbreak. It is also a government requirement. You can do this by:

- Writing your name, phone number and date of attendance on your collection envelope and dropping it in the collection basket
- Bring a slip of paper from home with your name, number of family members, phone number, and date of attendance and drop into the collection basket
- Or fill in the slip of paper provided for you in the book rack on the back of the pews and drop that in the collection basket on your way out of church

Thank you for your ongoing cooperation in this matter. This helps to keep us all safe.

CONFESSION: If anyone wishes to avail themselves of the sacrament of confession/reconciliation, come to the front of the iconostas before liturgy from **9:30 to 9:50**. When Father is ready, you can come to the sacristy (Father's side, on the left hand side), and stand in the doorway but do not enter the sacristy. (This seems to be the most workable way, for now and allows for safe distancing).
