NOTE: due to Covid restrictions, we will bless bottled, sealed water. When the faithful approach to receive Holy Communion at the end of Liturgy, you can take a bottle of blessed water – one per household – which will be made available at the front.

CONFESSION: If anyone wishes to avail themselves of the sacrament of confession/reconciliation, come to the front of the iconostas before liturgy from **9:30 to 9:50**. When Father is ready, you can come to the sacristy (Father's side, on the left hand side), and stand in the doorway but do not enter the sacristy. (This seems to be the most workable way, for now and allows for safe distancing).
