Attending Divine Liturgy on Thursday morning is an option to attending on Sunday. Collections can be left in the basket on Thursday as well. As a reminder: During Lent it is customary to replace the **First Antiphon** with “**The First Psalm of Typica**” on **pg. 21** of the **Liturgy Books** and the **Third Antiphon** is replaced with “**The Beatitudes**” on **pg. 27** of the **Liturgy Books**.

During Lent, at the end of Divine Liturgy, there will be the recitation of the Lenten Hymn, “**You have suffered/Preterpiviy.**” The people are asked to stay in their pews and simply bow their heads at the end of the hymn. Father and Deacon will do the prostrations on behalf of the congregation.
