As a reminder: During Lent it is customary to replace the **First Antiphon** with “**The First Psalm of Typica**” on **pg. 21** of the **Liturgy Books** and the **Third Antiphon** is replaced with “**The Beatitudes**” on **pg. 27** of the Liturgy Books.

During Lent, at the end of Divine Liturgy, there will be the recitation of the Lenten Hymn, “**You have suffered/Preterpiviy.**” The people are asked to stay in their pews and simply bow their heads at the end of the hymn. Father and Deacon will do the prostrations on behalf of the congregation.

CONFESSION: If anyone wishes to avail themselves of the sacrament of confession/reconciliation, come to the front of the iconostas before liturgy from **9:30 to 9:50**. When Father is ready, you can come to the sacristy (Father's side, on the left hand side), and stand in the doorway but do not enter the sacristy. (This seems to be the most workable way, for now and allows for safe distancing).
