CONFESSION: If anyone wishes to avail themselves of the sacrament of confession/reconciliation, come to the front of the iconostas before liturgy from **9:30 to 9:50**. When Father is ready, you can come to the sacristy (Father's side, on the left hand side) and stand in the doorway but do not enter the sacristy. (This seems to be the most workable way, for now and allows for safe distancing).

This is done in honour of the resurrection. For those who are unable to stand for any length of time, you are most welcome to sit. During the consecration, please remain standing and simply bow your heads in reverence.
