Provincial health restrictions have been changed for church attendance. Starting **March 20, 2021**, attendance for Divine Liturgy will increase to 70 people, while still maintaining social distancing. Masks must be worn and **you must register**. Attending Divine Liturgy on Thursday morning is an option to attending on Sunday. Collections can be left in the basket on Thursday as well. There are also many church services available on line through live streaming by going to the Eparchial website.

**As a reminder:** During Lent it is customary to replace the **First Antiphon** with “The First Psalm of Typica” on **pg. 21** of the **Liturgy Books** and the **Third Antiphon** is replaced with “The Beatitudes” on **pg. 27** of the Liturgy Books. **During Lent**, at the end of Divine Liturgy, there will be the recitation of the Lenten Hymn, “**You have suffered/Preterpiviy.**” The people are asked to stay in their pews and simply bow their heads at the end of the hymn. Father and Deacon will do the prostrations on behalf of the congregation.



**CONFESSION:** If anyone wishes to avail themselves of the sacrament of confession/reconciliation, come to the front of the iconostas before liturgy from **9:30 to 9:50**. When Father is ready, you can come to the sacristy (Father's side, on the left hand side) and stand in the doorway but do not enter the sacristy. (This seems to be the most workable way, for now and allows for safe distancing).

### NOTES FROM FR. ANDREI

1. On **Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday**, there will be a second basket (gift bag) available for the Dar Lubovy, or Easter Gift of Love for Fr. Andrei and Deacon Harrold should anyone wish to give a card or envelope for them.
2. Beginning on Easter Sunday and during the **40 days of the Easter season**, it is customary in the Eastern Rite, NOT to kneel but rather to stand in the places of the liturgy where we would normally kneel. This is done in honour of the resurrection. For those who are unable to stand for any length of time, you are most welcome to sit. During the consecration, please remain standing and simply bow your heads in reverence.
