CONFESSION: If anyone wishes to avail themselves of the sacrament of confession/reconciliation, come to the front of the iconostas before liturgy from **9:30 to 9:50**. When Father is ready, you can come to the sacristy (Father's side, on the left) and stand in the doorway but do not enter the sacristy. Father will also hear confessions by appointment.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

NOTES...

1. As a reminder: During Lent it is customary to replace the First Antiphon with “The First Psalm of Typica” on pg. 21 of the Liturgy Books and the Third Antiphon is replaced with “The Beatitudes” on pg. 27 of the Liturgy Books.

2. During Lent, at the end of Divine Liturgy on Sunday, there will be the singing of the Lenten Hymn, “You have suffered/Preterpiviy.” The people are asked to stay in their pews and simply bow their heads at the end of the hymn. Father and Deacon will do the prostrations on behalf of the congregation.

3. Sorokousty, or the Lenten prayers of recitation of the names of our deceased loved ones, will be done on Thursdays during Lent. The names of our loved ones will be mentioned about 10 minutes prior to Divine Liturgy, the panakhyda will follow at the end of liturgy. There is no charge for this; instead, an offering of non-perishable food items for the Food Bank will be appreciated. If anyone has a name(s) to add to your family list of deceased loved ones, text Father or drop a note with the name on it in the collection basket at the entrance to the church and it will be forwarded to him.

If you want to offer Liturgy intentions, please contact Fr. Andrei at 306-763-3645.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: If you or a family member are admitted to the hospital, your patient file will not include Fr. Andrei's name as your spiritual contact person. If you or your loved one would like to have spiritual services, such as visiting, praying, bringing the Holy Eucharist, hearing confession, anointing, or blessing of the sick, last rites, baptisms, provided by Fr. Andrei, you, or someone you trust, must contact him directly. Fr Andrei would like to do his very best to meet the spiritual needs of the parish.
