INFORMATION REGARDING UKRAINIAN IMMIGRANTS COMING TO PRINCE ALBERT



People have been asking about how they can help immigrants from Ukraine with clothing donations, etc. Is our church collecting things? The YWCA Settlement Services will be doing the intake of these immigrants, unless they are going directly to stay with someone in the community.

- Right now they have not had any official word of receiving immigrants from Ukraine
- They do not take donations of clothing or household items because they have no storage
- They have an arrangement with the Salvation Army that allows these people to come to their store and choose clothing for themselves, and Salvation Army does not charge them
- If a time comes when household items are required, the YWCA will make requests to the community through their web site, their face book page, and the local media (panow)
- People can make donations to the Salvation Army however they are not able to set aside items for the Ukrainian immigrants because they have no room either
