RESCRIPT

Permission to Relegate a Church Building to Profane but not Sordid Use

Whereas:

- A. The Ukrainian Catholic Parish of St. John the Baptist at Kindersley, Saskatchewan of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon has no known remaining parishioners.
- B. As a result of the above-mentioned lack of parishioners, the church building previously used by the parish located on Surface Parcel 147545196 in SE 25-27-24 W3, legally described as Parcel A Plan 101434081 Ext 12 has not been used for Divine Worship for a period exceeding 30 years. There is no possibility of restoring the church building to active use.
- C. There has been consultation with the Presbyteral Council of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon regarding the relegation of the church building to profane use at a duly constituted meeting held October 11, 2022, with unanimous consent having been given.
- D. All sacred items have been removed from the church building, including the exterior crosses which had been affixed to the exterior of the church building and identified it as a place of worship. These crosses have been erected at the parish's cemetery site.
- E. There are no parties remaining who have a legitimate claim of rights over the church building.


Now therefore, I, the undersigned Vicar-General of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon, in the absence of the Apostolic Administrator, Most Rev. Lawrence Huculak, OSBM, make the following Decree:

1. That pursuant to CCEO c. 873, the church building formerly utilized by the Ukrainian Catholic Parish of St. John the Baptist at Kindersley, Saskatchewan of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon be reduced to "profane but not sordid use".
2. The sale of the property is hereby ratified upon having confirmed that the purchaser has agreed to use the property for "profane but not sordid use".


I ORDER the promulgation of this decree through its publication on the Eparchial website.
