Gospel Reflection, The third week of Lent in the Byzantine Rite is dedicated to the Holy Cross. The gospel reading focuses on the conditions of discipleship. Two important quotes in this reading: 1) take up your cross and follow Me, 2) What benefit is it if one gained the whole world and then in the end lost his/her life? The first quote gives us direction – we must carry our crosses in life and assist others in carrying crosses as well. The second quote poses a question to every individual: we can own the entire world but what benefit is that if we are not alive to enjoy it? There's more to life than material things. Lent is a time we focus on the spiritual and the joy of eternal life which is yet to come! Fr. Andrei
