


2nd SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST – TONE 1 ALL THE SAINTS OF UKRAINE

Tropar, of All the Saints of Ukraine, tone 4:




O — Prin - ces and bish-ops glo - ri - fied in Christ,* you mo - nas - tics and mar - tyrs,*



Kondak of All the Saints Ukraine, tone 4:




You shine with bright — lights,* O di - vine - ly in - spi - red right - eous ones of our church,*
