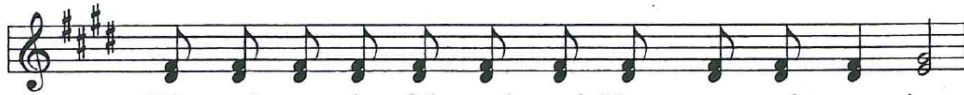


## Sunday after the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, Tone 6

When I cry to You dur-ing the day, O my God, You do not lis-ten, and there is

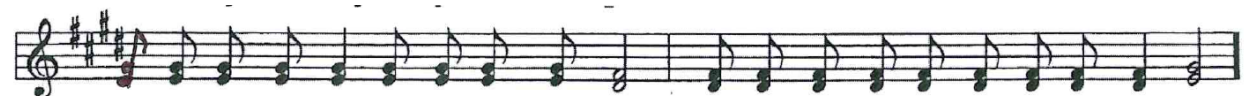


no rest for me at night. *Through the prayers..*

#### Glory be ..., tone 6:


